Statement made by Finland at the 2015 Mine Ban Treaty intersessional meeting

Thank you Mr. President,

I would like to start by thanking you for the way you are conducting this important meeting.

As you pointed out, Mr. President, Finland had more than one million anti-personnel land mines stockpiled when joining the mine ban treaty some years ago.

Currently we have destroyed over 99% of all our anti-personnel landmines. The remaining 4500 antipersonnel landmines yet to be destroyed, will be destroyed by the end of this year (2015).

We will in accordance with article 3 of the convention leave 16 500 anti-personnel landmines for training in the areas of mine detection, mine clearance and mine destruction. We estimate that this will serve our educational needs for several years.
