

**The Government of the Republic of Indonesia Intervention on  
Panel Discussion on Aligning donor coordination to support implementation of the  
Oslo Action Plan  
ISM APMBC  
30 June 2020**

Distinguished moderator and panelists, thank you for the elaboration on this topic.

Allow me to convey our view on the importance of international cooperation in supporting the effective implementation of this convention, as follows:

- Firstly, Indonesia always underscore the importance of disarmament and non-proliferation, from weapons of mass destruction to weapons that injures excessively and indiscriminately.
  - Particularly for landmines, Indonesia is of the view that the Mine Ban Treaty has become an important platform for the implementation of the international humanitarian law and it has enjoyed success in advancing its common goal through international diplomacy.
- Secondly, Indonesia welcomes the results of the 4<sup>th</sup> Review Conference and the adoption of Oslo Action Plan as a manifestation of our unwavering commitment to achieving a world free from anti personnel mines.
  - We believe that the full and effective implementation of the Convention by all State Parties is key in delivering the envisioned goals of protecting people and putting an end to the suffering and casualties caused by anti-personnel mines.
  - In implementing the action plan, international cooperation and assistance is key in ensuring effective implementation and compliance to the Convention are maintained.
- Thirdly, Indonesia believes that regional organizations has a strong role in the success of the convention.
  - Indonesia has been actively participating in ASEAN Regional Mine Action Centre or ARMAC which was established by ASEAN countries in September 2016 to assist ASEAN member states in research, knowledge and raising awareness on the effects of explosive remnants of war, including landmines.

In closing, Indonesia stands ready to work with relevant international or regional stakeholders towards achieving a world free of anti personnel mines by 2025.
