- o Advice on the Arrival Date for Delegates
 - Cambodia cordially invites ALL delegates to attend the Opening Ceremony and Reception
 - Delegates who plan to join the field trips are kindly requested to arrive Phnom Penh before or on 26 November 2011.
 - Delegates who plan to attend just the Opening Ceremony and Reception could arrive on 27 November 2011 (morning) the latest.
 - Delegates are encouraged to book the flights as early as possible to secure seats.

REGISTRATION

- o The Process
 - ❖ Registration is necessary to participate in the 11MSP
 - ❖ UN SG already issued invitation on 15-04-2011
 - List of Official Delegation (via Verbal Note) needs to be sent to UNODA
 - ❖ All delegates need to register on-line to receive the badge and to enable the host country to serve them better during their time in Cambodia.
 - On-line registration system (similarly modeled to the one used at the Cartagena Summit) will be opened in a few weeks
 - Registration Manual and Delegate Manual will be available on the 11MSP web site soon.

VISA

o The Process

- Except those ASEAN members that have visa exemption agreement with Cambodia, passport holders of other countries are required to obtain a visa to enter Cambodia
- ❖ A courtesy visa (gratis) will be provided to applicants
- ❖ Accreditation letter generated by the on-line system is required for the application to obtain a gratis visa
- ❖ Visa-on-arrival will be arranged for those having no reasonable access to nearby Cambodian embassies/ consulates. Those who have the means are discouraged from choosing this option.
- Imports of exhibition materials, printed publications, and media equipments that seek duty exemption require advanced application and customs clearance.



HOTEL BOOKING & AIRPORT TRANSFER

- ❖ EXOTISSIMO Cambodia has been designated official travel agent of the 11MSP
- ❖ As free shuttle buses only service designated official hotels, delegates are encouraged to make reservation through the agent at negotiated corporate rates
- ❖ Delegates staying at other hotels will be responsible for own transportation
- ❖ The list of official hotels and corporate rates is available during on-line registration and on the 11MSP web site
- ❖ Free airport transfer (airport <-> designate hotels) will be provided.
- ❖ Head of Delegation at ministerial level and above will be accorded with a courtesy sedan during the entire stay.
