- House that shelters the family from the weather
- Enough food to eat
- Access to drinking water no more than 5 minutes walk from house
- Children have access to school and adults have learning opportunities
- Access to primary health care
- Access to income generation opportunities
- Access to prosthetics, assistive devices and follow-up care
- Villagers and other disabled help each other
- Land free from mines
