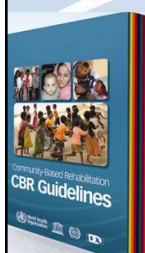


4. Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities

- CBR provides the operational methodology

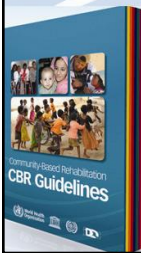
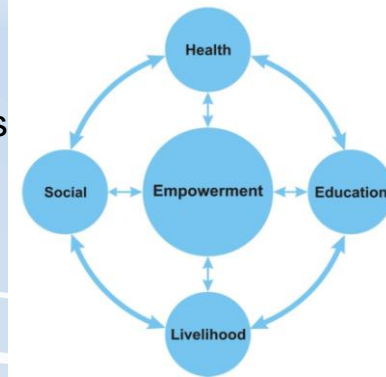

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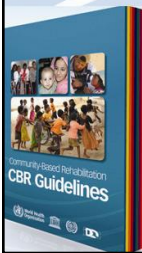
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CBR Guidelines

- Nearly 6 years of work
- Partnership among 3 UN organizations and 26 civil societies
- Contribution from more than 150 experts.
- Nearly 300 organizations from 29 countries took part in the field validation.
- 26 experts peer reviewed the document

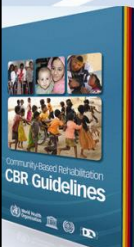
