A- Collection and Updating of Data Project on Landmine Victims

The Project is being implemented by CNIDAH with the collaboration of the provincial and municipal governments, traditional authorities, NGOs and national companies with extensive experience

Nowadays, 5 Provinces out of 18 have been completed, including the Province of Namibe, Huila, Cunene, Cabinda and Zaire.

About 3000 disabled landmine persons have been identified

E- Economic Reintegration



- 548 people trained in different areas where 499 men and 49 women
- Reintegration in the education sector of 137 secondary teachers and 23 specialists.
- Implementation of the "Job Creation Program" that benefited 17.589 disabled persons including landmine victims, distributed in different areas:

Employment of Landmine Victims


- Total of 578 landmine victims were employed

F- Public Policy and Laws for Disabled Persons



-In 2012 Angola approved:

- the Basic Law on Protection of Persons with Disabilities
- the National Strategy to implement this Law
- the National Council of the Disable Person

- the regulation to enable Angola to join the "Convention

on the Rights of Disabled Persons"
