

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The disability perspective from the legal, political and social view, should lead states to develop processes, specific governance programs in education, employment, health, rehabilitation and accessibility that result in public investment and budgeting for disability

The Legal Route of the Disability in Perú

Peru ratified 3 international Treaties: Convention No. 159 and Recommendation No. 168-ILO, Inter-American Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination against Persons with Disabilities, and the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities of the United Nations-CRPD. Convention of Ottawa, too

In December 2012, with the approval of the General Law on Persons with Disabilities, Peru started the adaptation of national legislation with the provisions of the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities of the United Nations

Nowadays, It continues the process of institutionalization of disability: Regulation of the General Law on Persons with Disabilities invites all three spheres of government and civil society, and the new Plan for Equal Opportunities (PIO) with vision to 2021, is the operating system path functional disability (SINAPEDIS)

In 2012, the First National Survey on Disability Specialist, with a sample size of 223,000 households and application of 163 questions began.

Budget available on all 3 levels of government

The budget disability is measured by results. For the first time in the country, there are currently 3 Budget Programs Disability: Employment, Education, Health, have a total investment of 16 million 806 thousand U.S. dollars. By 2014, only in Education, there are provided direct resources for 52 million \$ 857,000

in the years 2012 and 2013, Public budgets in disability for the three levels of government, represented 187 and 205 million, respectively. In 2014, by Public Budget Law, it is estimated that the 26 regional governments and 1,840 local governments should allocate \$ 243 million to the attention of Disability

In 2014, the Peruvian government will finance non-contributory pensions for people with severe disability and poverty, including victims of landmines



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The Management Employment Model "I'm Able"

1. This Model involves in the labor market to link people with disabilities and private institutions and also, more public entities.
2. It promotes the compliance with employment quota for persons with disabilities 5% in the public sector and 3% in private companies with more than 50 employees, that will start in 2015.

In 17 months of validity "I'm Able" has managed to place in public and private institutions, 1,412 people with disabilities.
