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I. INTRODUCTION

- Under Article 7, paragraph 1, of the Convention, each State Party shall report to the 1. Secretary-General of the United Nations as soon as practicable, and in any event not later than 180 days after the entry into force of this Convention for that State Party on items (a) to (i). Further, the States Parties shall update these reports annually, covering the last calendar year, and submit them to the Secretary-General of the United Nations not later than 30 April of each year (Article 7, para.2). To facilitate this undertaking and to promote comparability and evaluation of data, in May 1999 the First Meeting of the States Parties adopted the standard reporting format, developed in consultation with States Parties. In September 2000. at the Second Meeting of the States Parties in Geneva, the Article 7 reporting format was amended to include an additional form "Form J: Other relevant matters". This form provides States Parties with the opportunity to report voluntarily on matters pertaining to compliance and implementation not covered by the formal reporting requirements contained in Article 7, in particular to report on activities undertaken with respect to Article 6: on assistance provided for the care and rehabilitation, and social and economic reintegration, of mine victims.1
- 2. To make the reporting procedure more efficient a cover page of the annual Article 7 report has been adopted by the States Parties at the 4th Meeting of the States Parties to the Convention. The idea of the cover page is that the reporting party will indicate if something has changed in relation to the previous report. If nothing has changed, the reporting party will limit itself to filling the cover page.²
- 3. This report gives an overview of replies transmitted by the States Parties on the standard reporting forms, as of 4 September 2003. The full contents of replies are available on the Internet³.
