Activities in the NW parts of the Republic of Macedonia for the implementation of the Ottawa Convention

First Phase: October 2001 - May 2004

- Regions of: v.Lavce, v.Dzepciste, v.Tearce,
 v.Ropalce, v.Trebos, v.Neprosteno, v.Semsevo,
 v.Gracani, v.Matejce, v.Alasevce, v.Slupcane,
 v.Aracinovo, v.Opae, v.Ratae, v.Lojane, v.Vaksince.
- Financial support from the budget of the Republic of Macedonia and donor countries: USA, Canada, Japan, the Republic of Slovenia; and international funds.



Activities realized in the NW parts of the Republic of Macedonia for the implementation of the Ottawa Convention:

The last phase was realized in the period from 17th July, till 15th of September 2006

- Region around the village of Vejce
- Region around the village of Grachani
- Region around the village of Tanusevci

The last phase of search and de-mining in the region was realized by a Macedonian de-mining team

Financial support for the last stage in the amount of 41.000 USD were provided by the the USA and with involvement of ITF-Slovenia







Octomber 2001 - September 2006:

- · cleaned 6 681 358 m² area
- 558 anti-personnel mines were discovered and destroyed
- 951 other explosives remnants of war were destroyed





The Republic Of Macedonia officially declared the fulfillment of the Articles 4 and 5 obligations of the Ottawa Convention on its territory as of 15th Sept. 2006





Achievements: (1)

- Fulfillment of its obligations related to the Ottawa Convention
- Confidence building amongst the countries in the Region in the field of disarmament
- Contribution towards the regional initiative: SEE- region free of AP mines by 2009





Achievements: (2)

- Improvement of the safety in border zones
- Strengthening of the regional stability
- Normalization of the life of the population in the mine affected regions and upgrading preconditions for further economic growth in these areas





Other undertakings:

AP Mines retained under Article 3

- I. On July 10 2006, 4000 mines were destroyed at the Krivolak army field:
 - -1400mines PMA-1
 - 600mines PMA-2
 - -2000mines PMR-2A



Additional Results:



II. Discovered and destroyed UXO:

- 680 artillery shells (75-155mm);
- 125 hand-grenades;
- 6 air bombs (explosive charge 100-150kg.)
- -32 mortar grenades

Total: 743 UXO
