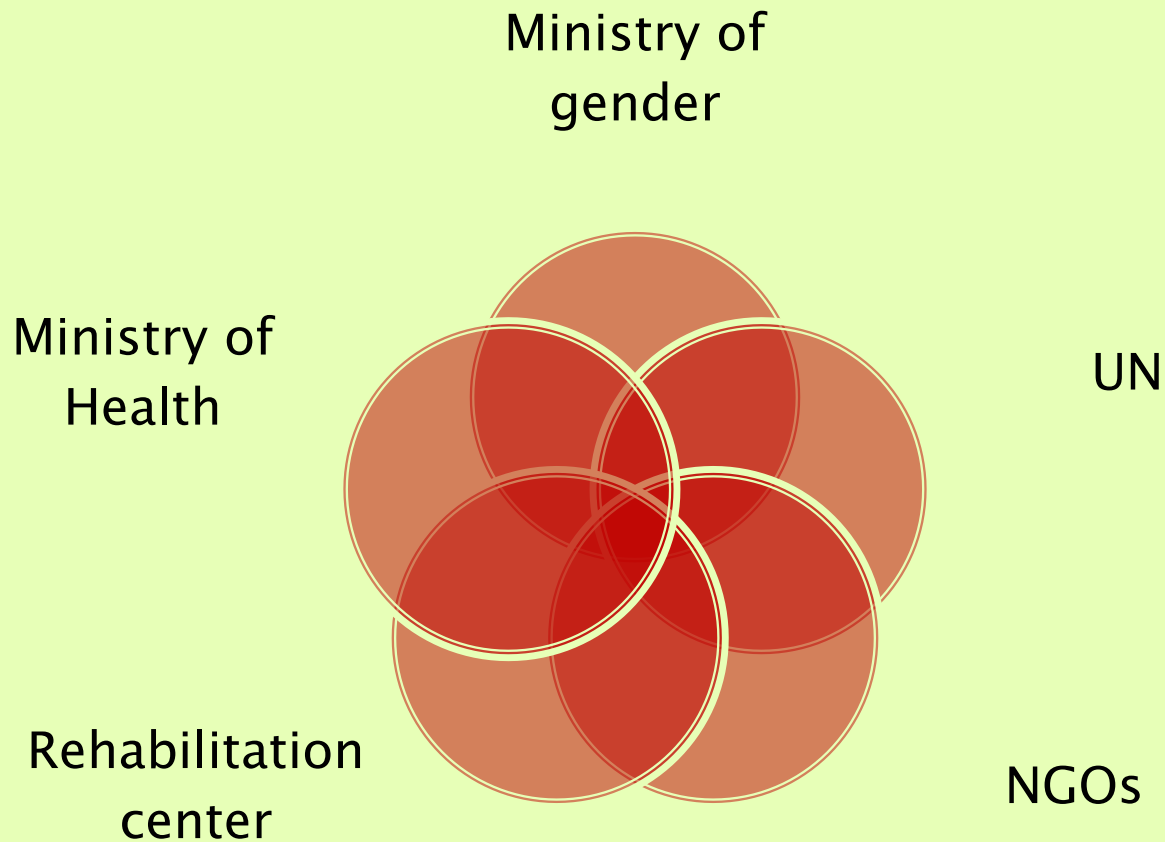

# Data collection

- ▶ Sufficient geographic coverage
- ▶ A classification for victims/survivors
- ▶ Developed in close consultation with victims
- ▶ Sharing data in a timely manner with relevant actors
- ▶ Includes needs assessment
- ▶ Mapping available services and capacities

# Monitoring – some practicalities

- ▶ **Mechanism to monitor** on a regular basis by the coordination group.
- ▶ **Reporting format (tool)** for all relevant actors to report to the coordination body on progress in achieving the objectives.
- ▶ **Sharing** data with ministries, health & welfare sectors and service providers

# Roles in Monitoring

- ▶ Ministries
- ▶ NGOs
- ▶ DPOs/Survivors
- ▶ Donors
- ▶ Members of other coordination committees
- ▶ Other actors

# Article 7 Reporting

An excellent opportunity to:

- ▶ Report progress on objectives
- ▶ Give brief updates on planned activities
- ▶ New policy or policy implementation
- ▶ Note outcomes of coordination
- ▶ Provide statistics from across sectors working on VA
