

... so that he/she can attain and maintain the highest possible level of independence and quality of life: physically, mentally, socially and vocationally

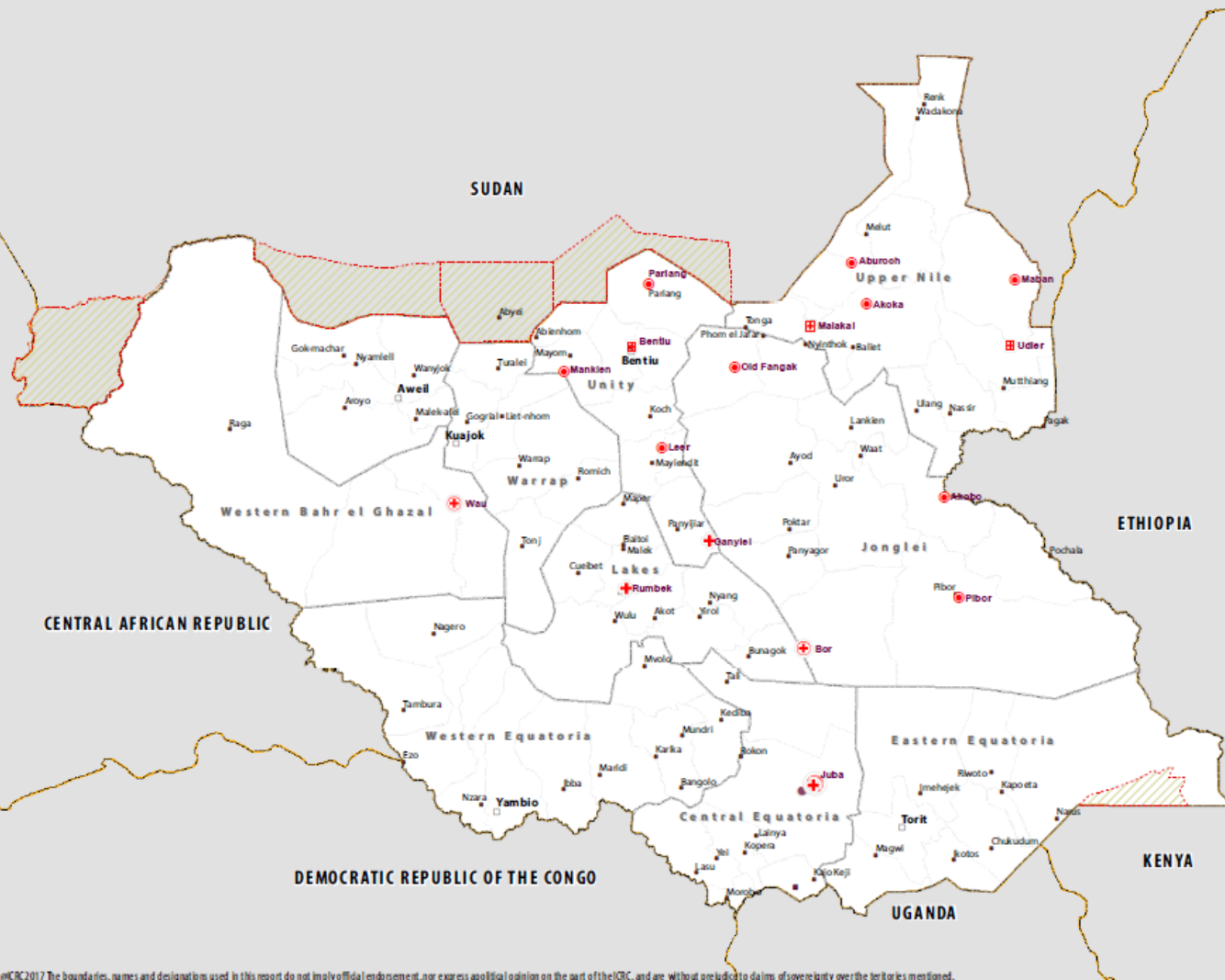
Physical Rehabilitation: In ICRC context

- To provide equal access to all people with physical disabilities to avail the services
- To ensure the quality of PR services and meet the standards set by the ICRC
- To facilitate a gradual and steady handover to the service providers towards the sustainability of the service provision
- To enhance the social inclusion of the beneficiaries
