- Social Security Law (1980).
- Iraqi Constitution, Law # 38 on the Care of Persons with Disabilities and Special Needs (2005).
- Law to Compensate Victims of Military Operations and Terrorist Attacks from 2003 Onwards (2009).
- Constitution of the Kurdistan Region and Law # 22 on the Rights and Privileges of Persons with Disabilities and Those with Special Needs (2009).
- Iraq signed CRPD (Law # 32 of Iraqi Constitution – 2012)
- Social Protection Law (2014).

Opportunities for Mainstreaming VA/PwD into Broader Development



- Iraq National Development Plan 2018 – 2022 (*under human and social development*)
- Iraq Reconstruction and Development Framework (*MoP & World Bank – 2018*)
- E-Governance (New Cabin)
- National Strategic and Executive Plan for Mine Action 2017-2021 (*UNMAS*).
- CRPD - stresses provision of means for persons with disabilities to live a decent life and promote their reintegration into society.
- Sustainable Development Goals (*i.e. Poverty reduction*)

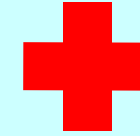
